



Blood Titers to Confirm Serologic Immunity to Disease

Blood testing to verify serologic immunity to disease must be done by a licensed medical laboratory. Health insurance companies usually require a written prescription by a physician in order to pay for the test. A student may use any physician and medical laboratory he/she wishes.

PHYSICIAN OPTIONS:

The student may use his/her own personal physician or a medical facility of choice.

Michael Silvers, D.O., MPH with Immuvax Travel Medicine Clinic can provide these services to students who may not have other resources. A student who wishes to use Immuvax services may pick up a written lab prescription from the office and take it to any laboratory. The form will authorize the medical laboratory to perform the proper blood test. The results will be faxed to Dr. Silvers where the student can receive a copy and interpretation of the test results.

Dr. Silver's fee is \$30 for the prescription form and interpretation of the results; payable at time of picking up the form.
